



Resident Volunteer Position Announcement

The Silvertown Fire District is currently seeking motivated individuals to join as Resident Volunteer Firefighters (RV). The position is for a two year program, with the possibility to a 3 year program depending on the type of educational program the RV is enrolled in. The RV will be assigned to a rotating shift schedule. During assigned shift the RV will respond to calls for service and participate in training. The Silvertown Fire District will provide sleeping quarters, laundry facilities, Wi-Fi, and kitchen facilities. **Full time living arrangements are available.**

The Fire District will pay for up to 12 credit hours per academic term in the form of educational reimbursement up to a maximum of the current in state tuition rate per credit hour term. **A stipend is also paid** for each response to calls for service as well as drills attended.

18 minute drive time to the Chemeketa Brooks campus.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Valid Driver's License.
- At least 18 years of age.
- High school diploma or GED.
- A driving record that is insurable by the Fire Districts insurance carrier.
- Full time enrollment in a Fire Suppression Program at any college.
