FLAG SALUTE CHIEF'S REPORT-

- 1. Thanks to Jesse and crew who helped with the grounds at Station 1.
- 2. Civil Service meets at 0900 at Station 1 tomorrow. We will be hiring a Lt. Assistant Training Officer soon. Keith and Keith are working on this process.
- 3. We have been involved in a lot of wildfire prevention the last couple of weeks. We will be involved in the wildfire safety event at the fire wise house in the Oregon Garden next month.
- 4. Still struggling with ESO issues especially with the report process and the CAD upgrade. If there are problems with ESO getting CAD data imported, please let Bill know ASAP.
- 5. We received the summer wildfire up staff grant (like we got last year) and we received a three year grant for a fulltime firefighter position. The fulltime position will require matching funds each year; 10%, 25%, 50%

ASSISTANT CHIEF'S REPORT-

- 1. Ed gave an update on the succession schedule for the Assistant Chief position; starting the first part of June Keith V will become the authorized signer for DPSST related matters, on June 30th Keith will take possession of the C402 unit and will assume the role of AC on July 1st.
